

SCHOOL FEES AND OBLIGATIONS

Student fees and obligations are now accessible via the Powerschool Parent Portal. The PowerSchool app shows the total amount owed, and the web version of PowerSchool shows a more detailed view of student fees under a parent login. Students may incur a variety of fees to the school including charges for lost or broken items, technology damages and replacements, athletic uniforms, band/chorus uniforms, and class dues.

Obligation payments can be paid by check made out to PHS or by cash, and should be turned in to the school as follows:

- Main Office collects:
 - chromebook related fees
 - lost/damaged books and calculator fees
 - athletic fees
- Band/chorus teachers collect:
 - band/chorus fees
- Class Advisors collect:
 - class dues payments*

***CLASS DUES:**

Students pay dues to help fund activities the class will participate in during their senior year. Students can pay the \$100 in total or can pay dues in three increments.

Dues payment # 1 - \$33.00 (Due by June 1 of students freshman year)

Dues payment # 2 - \$33.00 (Due by June 1 of students sophomore year)

Dues payment # 3- \$34.00 (Due by June 1 of students junior year)

Total dues are \$100.00

Please note that students who are delinquent on their class dues will not be able to participate in school sponsored activities, including sports, the following fall until their balance is paid.
