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As you may be aware, the secondary school is accredited by the New England Association of Schools and Colleges (NEASC). The decennial process includes a comprehensive self-evaluation followed by a weeklong site visit. At the conclusion, commendations are cited and recommendations are provided. One of the NEASC expectations is that each school must identify and describe in detail 21st century learning expectations which are vital to success in college and career pursuits. The 21st century learning expectations are embedded in 7 school-wide analytic rubrics recently posted to our school website. These rubrics were developed by the staff and re-titled in June 2017. Commencing with this report card, we are informing students and families about student performance linked to the identified 21st century learning expectations. Report cards will provide ratings: Exemplary, Proficient, Developing and Below Standard.*

Our goal is to provide feedback to all students and their families while students attend our Secondary School. Before graduating, each student will receive feedback about their performance on each of the seven school-wide analytic rubrics.
